Volunteers need to be up to date with COVID-19 vaccines. DWC monitors and reviews the vaccination status for the destination country. EVOLVING



Analysis of the **best data available** on reported cases, deaths, tests and hospitalizations within the population of the destination country. EVOLVING

DWC TRIP PROCESS



Compliance with **travel advisories** for destination country, entry/exit requirements, in-country restrictions in effect, and return testing requirements. EVOLVING



An **Expression of Interest** is completed through DWC's website. This is free and allows our team to gauge interest.

PAYMENTS

Volunteers will be contacted to pay the balance of trip costs with their **final donation*** through DWC's payment portal.

With sufficient interest in a trip, the formal registration process begins. A **\$600 deposit*** secures a place on the team. **6-4 months prior**

DEPARTURE

This is the specific day that the **volunteer begins their trip** and is typically the date used for travel insurance policies.

Flights booked through our preferred travel agent are eligible for a charitable tax receipt.*
